Judge Selection

The show will have two different judges (one on Saturday and one on Sunday) the judges will be selected by our committee and will be judges that not only have a passion for evaluating hogs but also work in the industry and have vested interest in what they do. The judges will be announced two weeks after the November 1st entry deadline on our website as well as our Facebook page.

Points

Class Points-The number of points received for 1st place will be 8 points, exhibitors thereafter will receive one less point respectively based off placing in class and if there are more than 8 hogs in a class no points will be awarded after all points have been given out. Ex. - In a class of 15, 1st place receives 8, 2nd receives 7, 3rd receives 6 and so on.

Division Points: Grand & Reserve Champions will receive Ten & Five Points respectively in each division (1-6)

Supreme Overall and Reserve Champions: Will receive 11 and 6 points respectively. No other points will be given.

Any tie breakers will be determined by showmanship placing tallied from both days

Camping/Trailers/Parking

*Camping will be available outside grounds the day of the show in the parking lot (unsecured-50 dollars for the weekend)

* Limited inside grounds trailer spots (First come first serve through entry form only).

Limited (7) spots available with electric (Reservation are 150 dollars for the weekend (35 amps)).
